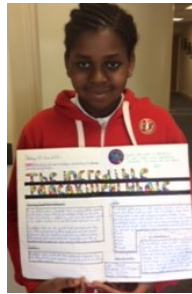

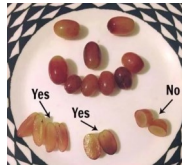



Quiz Night

Pupil Questionnaire

The Junior Parliament launched a behaviour survey for classes to complete as part of their CGNN assembly. The results show that children feel safe in school and the large majority feel that their own and behaviour of others in school is good.

94% of children surveyed understand the school policy for behaviour.

A large majority of children surveyed feel the school policy is fair.

90% of children feel they follow the school rules in their classroom all or most of the time.

45% of children think they follow them every day in every lesson.

85% of children feel they follow the school rules on the playground all or most of the time.

45% of children think they follow them every day at every playtime.

8% of children feel their classes behaviour is not good enough and could be improved.

12% of children feel that behaviour on the playground could be improved.

94% of children think the school helps children who find it a challenge to follow the school rules.

94% of children say they feel safe in school.

100% of children could name adults they would talk to if they have a problem in school.
