### ***Our new theme topic***

We are all looking forward to an exciting term of learning. Our theme this term is a science one – life on our planet – with some DT too – making a giant pizza. We will start with a letter from Jack, investigating different plants and leaves, with a trip to Brandon Marsh (letter to follow nearer the time). We will be growing our own beanstalks, looking at different parts of a plant and where food comes from. We are also looking at different animals, insects and birds and grouping them and human senses.

**Reading** – please continue to read at least three times every week. Also make sure that your child brings in their **reading book and reading diary to school every day.**

Children read to adults in school and are often rewarded for remembering their books!

**'MyOn'** children can also log on to MyOn and read from the large selection of books available there.

**Maths** – Please continue to practise times tables on **TT Rockstars**. In addition, maths homework is loaded on to **SeeSaw on a Friday**. This is usually linked to our maths learning that week in school.

**PE** – ***is on Wednesday and Friday*** for both Lime and Juniper. Some children also do PE with their class have PE kit in school every day.

**Forest School** – Is on a ***Wednesday***. So please make sure that the children have warm clothes, and you can ask them about the great fun activities they do there!
