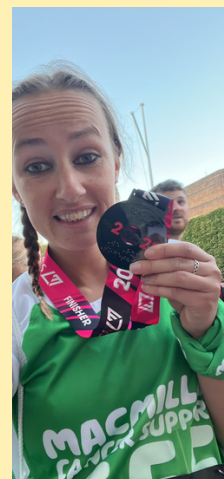
School Parliament
