

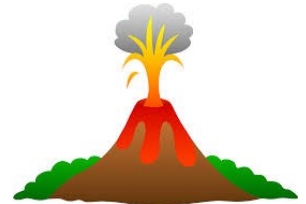

Covid Practices

Online Learning

Due to COVID we have to limit the transference of books and equipment between home and school which is why all your child's homework is now being put online. If your child is required to isolate for a period of time, we will put their work on Showbie (Y3 - Y6) and Seesaw (YR - Y2). If your child is isolating it is your responsibility to make sure that they complete the online learning. We know that this is a challenge for everyone especially if you haven't got equipment at home for your child to do it on, if this is the case please contact school so we can support in any way we can.

Please can I remind parents to check that you can log into Showbie (Y3 - Y6) and Seesaw (YR - Y2) and contact us if you have any difficulties with this. Please can you make sure that your child posts their homework every week online.



Parent Governor
