

# Zoom Acceptable Use Agreement

By your child joining their scheduled Zoom video call, you are agreeing that they will follow the information outlined in the Zoom acceptable use agreement.

## Pupils and families:



Pupils should not share meeting ID numbers or passwords with anyone else. These are unique to your child's class and will only work for that scheduled meeting. If you require the meeting ID or password again, please contact the class teacher directly on Showbie who will be able to resend.



When joining the Zoom video call, pupils should use their first name (as they are known at school). If your child knows that there is more than one pupil known by their name in the class, they should include the first letter of their surname (Joe B). Pupils should not use their full names.



All activity Zoom video calls will be monitored by our staff and technicians.



Pupils are not permitted to screen shot or record any of the meetings.



Pupils should ideally attend sessions in shared spaces in the house and with permission from an adult.



Pupils should be appropriately dressed.



Families should consider the background that will appear behind the pupil when they join their meeting. Where possible this should be plain/clear background.



If pupils don't behave respectfully during the sessions, they may be removed from the meeting.



Pupils should only use the chat feature in Zoom if they are directed by the class teacher or need to ask the class teacher a question. This should not be used for pupils to chat amongst themselves.



All pupils should have their camera on at all times during the meeting.
