Must do tasks: These are tasks that we expect all children to be practicing every week at home this half term.

Read at least x3 a week (Please return on a Wednesday so that reading diaries can be checked and books changed)

Practicing name writing using correct letter formation

Watch the Read, write, inc videos and practicing writing weekly letter sounds with correct formation

Count objects accurately 5, recognise numerals 1-5, match number of objects to correct number and order 1-5

Chat: What does 'family' mean? Are all families the same? Who is in your family?

Play: Draw a picture of your family and write your name. You could try to label your family and pets too!

Read: A story that is a family favourite

These tasks are some ideas that you might like to complete at home over the next half term. They will support your child's learning of the theme. Please upload pictures and videos to Seesaw, we would love to see your work.

Chat: Who is the tallest person in your family? Who is the shortest?

Play: Choose 5 toys and put them in order, which one is longest? Which one is the shortest?

Read: Titch (a copy will be uploaded to seesaw)

Chat: What is it like in Autumn?

Play: Practice dressing yourself for a cold Autumn day to play outside. Can you put your coat on and do up the zip? Can you put your hat/scarf/gloves on?

Read: Go outside and read a story - take a photo for seesaw of you doing some cosy reading

Chat: What is your favourite toy?

Play: Make up a story using your favourite toy as the main character. Maybe Teddy could have an adventure at the beach.

Read: Can you record your story and upload it to seesaw?



Chat: What is your favourite colour?

Play: Go on a colour hunt... how many things can you find around your house that are your favourite colour?

Read: Elmer (a copy will be uploaded to seesaw)
